

PLEASE READ... BETHANY MANOR COVID-19 UPDATE FOR BETHANY RESIDENTS AND FAMILIES – JANUARY 6, 2021

You are receiving this communication because you are a resident of Bethany, or you have provided, and/or a Bethany resident(s) has provided your email address as they have identified you as their family/friend contact person.

Regarding our COVID-19 cases, for your information, all three cases have cleared their quarantine periods. The Saskatchewan Health Authority has not been able to establish any connection between the Manor Phase 1 cases and the case in the Tower. For this reason, Bethany Manor continues to be labelled by the Health Authority as a “suspect outbreak” location and the 30-day restriction period did not have to restart with the case in the Tower. Based on their investigation, the Health Authority will consider lifting the restriction period, provided that no new cases emerge, by the end of Sunday, January 10, 2021. This determination will be finalized by a Medical Health Officer on Monday, January 11, 2021.

We will issue another communiqué on Monday, January 11, 2021 to inform you of the Medical Officer’s decision, and until then, common areas continue to be off-limits. We will also provide pertinent details on common/activity area usage, visitors, and other information in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority and the Saskatchewan Housing Corporation.

Please note that the mask wearing order for public indoor spaces continues to be in effect until we hear otherwise from the provincial authorities. Please continue to practice social distancing, mask wearing and hand hygiene protocols.
