

PLEASE READ... APRIL 14, 2021 UPDATE ON PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER CHANGE

You are receiving this communication because you are a resident of Bethany, or you have provided, and/or a Bethany resident(s) has provided your email address as they have identified you as their family/friend contact person.

In response to the surge of COVID variants please note the Public Health Order information below from the government website:

*Effective April 13, 2021, all indoor gatherings in private dwellings throughout Saskatchewan are limited to immediate households only (individuals, who live on their own, are permitted to meet with one household of less than five and always the same household). [Please note that if individuals who live on their own are visiting with members of an **external** household, those visits should occur in that external household, not inside Bethany suites].*

Public and private outdoor gatherings are permitted up to 10 persons. People in attendance must ensure that physical distancing of at least two metres between households is maintained.

The new Public Health Order will also include limits of worship gathering sizes to allow no more than 30 people effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, April 16.

These Public Health Order measures are in effect until April 26 and will be reviewed at that time.

This means that, for the time being, we are back to essential visitors only. The sense of the government directive is to eliminate gatherings of any kind for the next two weeks.

Due to the tremendous concern around COVID variants please note:

- Do not have out of province visitors in your home. Outside visits are safer.
- Do not travel to, or accept visitors from, the Regina area.

The Bethany Villa Personal Care Home remains under stricter quarantine requirements therefore visitors are not permitted.

We ask that you continue to be vigilant with the regular protocols of social distancing, mask wearing, and hand hygiene.
